

# JD Edwards Day One

## *An Introduction to ERP*

### College Level Education

Students learn the history and purpose of ERP, the UX-One user interface for JD Edwards, and use the normal training “company” to experience and practice typical ERP functions using EnterpriseOne. They finish with an overview of security issues, and a glimpse into how ERP supports “digital transformation.”

- ▶ All lectures are pre-recorded with extensive supporting materials and on-line quizzes
- ▶ Facilitator can conduct weekly coaching calls
- ▶ Student membership in iLearnERP’s “End User Academy” for related learning paths
- ▶ Live practice sessions on iLearnERP’s “demo” system with detailed, self-guided instructions tied to course module and quiz questions

Experience this 15-lesson introduction to modern ERP systems using Oracle’s JD Edwards EnterpriseOne as a live, working example.
